Declaration

Partially compliant

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard, due to the non-compliances listed below.

Non-accessible content

- 1.2.3 Prerecorded videos with audio do not have synchronized captions
- 1.2.5 Prerecorded videos lack audio descriptions or alternative versions
- 1.2.9 Live or recorded videos do not provide live audio descriptions
- 1.3.1 The layout is only partially structured semantically with headings (h1–h6), lists, and tables
- 1.4.12 Text spacing cannot be customized (line height, paragraph spacing, etc.)
- 2.2.4 Animations, sliders, or moving content lack pause or disable controls
- 2.4.1 There is no skip link to allow quick access to the main content
- 2.4.6 Headings and semantic structures are partially missing, making page scanning harder
- 3.1.2 Not all text sections in a language other than the main language of the site are marked with a lang attribute
- 3.3.4 Forms do not provide a review/confirmation summary before final submission
- 4.1.1 HTML and CSS code may not fully validate according to W3C validators

Additionally, downloadable documents (e.g., PDF, DOC, DOCX, PPT) such as newsletters and school materials available on the site are not accessible. Some of the reported errors are a consequence of the CMS's underlying structural design
